Like most ungulates, deer leave clumps or clusters of elongated pellets.



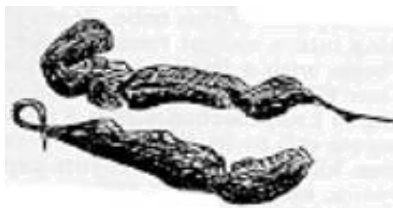
Deer
